Fall Equine Dentistry Lecture & Wet Lab

Humane Society of Missouri

This dental lecture and wet lab will provide 18.5 hours of dental-focused continuing education.

Dr. Dennis Rach has extensive equine dentistry experience in addition to being the designer of the PowerFloat equine dental instrument. The lecture will consist of basic anatomy and physiology of the oral cavity, dental instrumentation and techniques, sedation techniques, and dental pathology and treatment. The dental wet lab will be intensively hands-on.

Veterinarians will be paired up to perform floating and other dental procedures on live horses. Each station will have a PowerFloat available. There will also be a variety of speculums, lights, and extraction forceps available for your use. Each participant is encouraged to bring their own dental equipment so we can all get a better idea of what is available on the market.

Please email Dr. Bruce Whittle (bwhittle@socket.net) with a list of your equipment. Each pair of veterinarians will be able to work on 8 to 10 horses over the period of the wet lab sessions.

This continuing education session will be a great opportunity for veterinarians not performing much dentistry or for those who just want to further hone their skills. The MVMA will provide a news release for each participant to their local media to show the public that Missouri veterinarians are interested in equine dentistry. This will also give us an opportunity to help the St. Louis Humane Society horse facility by providing needed dental work in exchange for our learning experience.

Please register early as participation is limited to 16 due to the intensive structure of the wet lab.
