Why Give to the IAHF?

The IAHF has supported many projects and scholarships since its Inception including:

Animal Welfare

The IAHF sponsors, advertises, and coordinates a public forum each winter for the public to attend. Topics have included behavior issues and shelter medicine. The IAHF sponsors the Guardian Award presented by the Indiana Veterinary Medical Associations' Animal Welfare Committee.

Scholarships

Each year the IAHF provides scholarships to Indiana students at the Purdue University School of Veterinary Medicine.

The IAHF provides at least one \$500 scholarship to a veterinary technician student.

Each year the IAHF sends at least one recent graduate to the AVMA Leadership Conference through the Larry Borst Leadership Endowment Fund established through the foundation.

Disaster Relief

The IAHF raised funds related to the Hurricane Katrina in 2005. These funds were used to provide grants to veterinarians in Indiana who treated animals as a result of Hurricane Katrina. Funds are available in the event of a future disaster.

Mission of the Foundation:

The mission of the Indiana Animal Health Foundation (IAHF) is to provide financial assistance to individuals and institutions for educational and scientific purposes, in order to advance science for the benefit of animal health in Indiana.

Contributions to the Indiana Animal Health Foundation are tax deductible within the limits of the Internal Revenue Code.

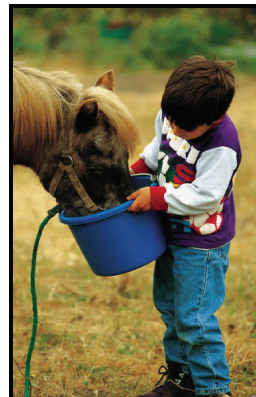


Donations to the Indiana Animal Health Foundation....
